UC ReX can help! The UC ReX Data Explorer tool is a secure, web-based system that organizes data from 13.6 million patient records across the University of California's five medical centers into a common format and allows authorized UC researchers, clinicians and administrators to access that data for research, clinical quality improvement and administrative inquiries.
